GENERAL ORDER 10-04

This General Order supersedes General Order 98-33.

The Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court and the Chief Judge of the District of Arizona have previously agreed to create a State-Federal Judicial Council of Arizona. The Council was created to provide a vehicle for direct and personal communication between judges of the State and Federal Courts in Arizona concerning matters of mutual interest and concern, including but not limited to:

- 1.) Elimination of actual and potential conflicts between the two judicial systems
- 2.) Development of methods to improve the operation of the two systems
- 3.) Improvement of the quality of representation and ethics of attorneys practicing in the two systems
- 4.) Exploration and development of methods to utilize scarce judicial assets to benefit the two systems and the citizens of the state and district
- 5.) Sharing of materials and information that may apply to, or impact on the two systems

1 6.) Fostering of closer cooperation for resolution of joint issues

2 **IT IS ORDERED** that the United States District Court for the District of Arizona
3 shall continue its participation in the State-Federal Judicial Council of Arizona for the
4 reasons and purposes set forth above.

5 **ORGANIZATION:** The Council shall continue to consist of at least five
6 representatives from the federal judiciary. The Chief Judge shall determine the number of
7 members of the federal delegation and the terms of membership. The number of members
8 in the two delegations need not necessarily be equal.

9 **MEMBERS:** The Council shall meet at least once a year at the time of the annual state
10 judicial conference. The Council may, from time to time, also schedule such other meetings
11 as circumstances dictate.


