


1 All persons not specifically authorized by this General Order to carry firearms upon
2 courthouse grounds are prohibited from carrying or possessing any firearm upon courthouse
3 grounds in any manner.

4 The term "courthouse grounds" includes all property owned, leased or used by the
5 federal government appurtenant to any facility utilized for federal court proceedings within
6 the District of Arizona. "Courthouse grounds" also includes property used from time to time
7 by the federal court for the purposes of conducting federal court proceedings, on the days that
8 such court proceedings take place. "Courthouse grounds" includes, but is not limited to the
9 walkways, steps, courtyards, plazas, and parking lots of these courthouses. Authorization
10 under this General Order to possess firearms on courthouse grounds does not authorize any
11 person to carry firearms within courthouse buildings. This prohibition shall not apply to
12 firearms lawfully possessed and kept in locked vehicles authorized to be parked in
13 courthouse parking lots, so long as the firearm is kept in such vehicle and not accessed while
14 the vehicle is parked on courthouse grounds.

15 III. Distribution:

16 This General Order shall be available to the public and a copy thereof sent to all
17 federal law enforcement agencies and all state and local law enforcement agencies who
18 regularly appear in the U.S. Courts.
